

HIGHLIGHTS IN ATHLETICS


















First Baptist Athletics had twelve varsity teams compete at their respective state tournaments during the 2022-2023 school year. In the Spring, the boys soccer team had its best finish since the 1990's by making a strong run to the state semi-finals. The Varsity Cross Country Teams also had one of their best finishes in years with Edings Walpole finishing 9th in the state and the boys teams coming in 7th place overall. The Varsity Boys and Girls Basketball teams continued their strong runs over the past several years as both teams reached the state semi-finals. 88% of the First Baptist National Honor Society played at least one sport and one-third of the First Baptist National Honor Society were multiple sport athletes during the 2022-2023 season. 228 First Baptist athletes participated in middle school, JV and varsity sports during the 2022-2023 season. 76% of high school students at First Baptist play at least one sport and one-third of our high school student-athletes play multiple varsity sports at First Baptist.




