


## CHARLESTON WRAP FUNDRAISER

Knowing that 95% of teens regularly use a smartphone and 45% say they are almost online constantly, we want to get ahead of the game and transform the way our young people view and use the internet as well as social media.

The #WinatSocial program empowers students, parents and educators to navigate social experiences -ONLINE & OFFLINE- in healthy high character ways. Every family in our school can access the parent portal by logging onto www.thesocialinstitute.com and click login and create a new account. If you need the code to activate the account, please reach out and email me. Then you can access playbooks which feature expert breakdowns of the most popular apps right now including TikTok, YouTube, Instagram, Snapchat, Among Us, Fortnite and more. You can find everything you need to know about these platforms in a language that is easy to understand.

The Social Standard we focused on in September was STRIKE A BALANCE. This standard is all about balancing our time and attention on technology with the people around us.

- 5th grade focused on balancing their time on tech to reach their goals
- 6th grade worked on sharing strategies to help friends and family balance their time on tech
- 7th concentrated on breaking down when to text vs when to talk
- 8th grade worked on how to strike a balance with technology
